Ladybirds have worked really hard this week. We have been sharing the story 'Elmer' and then identifying the characters and sequencing the story.

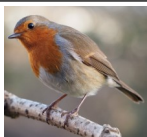

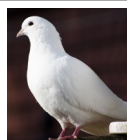
Learning For Life

Rabbits This week Rabbits had a fantastic music lesson doing action songs, and following fast and slow rhythms.

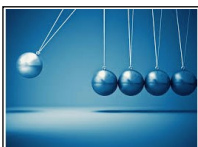

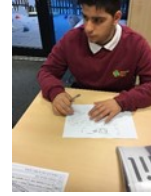

Twice weekly rapid COVID-19 testing

• Complete a Lateral Flow Test on your child - AGED OVER 11 only two times a week. Do this ONLY if they are able to take part without causing anxiety.

• Complete a Lateral Flow Test for you and all your family members (aged over 11) two times a week.

• Return all your lateral flow tests result to the government website www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result

• Return your child's lateral flow test result including all negative results to the school email address: results@tettenhallwoodschoo.org.uk

• To get into a routine - test on a Sunday evening or Monday morning then again on a Wednesday evening or a Thursday morning

Please continue with the twice weekly lateral flow tests. Testing kits are sent home with pupils aged 11 or over. This will help to keep us all as safe as possible. We would like to thank you all for your continued support. It is important that if you or a member of your household become unwell in any way, with any symptom's not including the COVID symptoms, you must book a PCR Test.

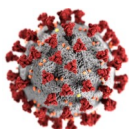

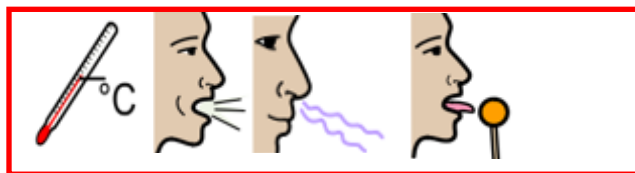
Coronavirus (COVID-19) - School Update

Symptoms are:

- ♦ High temperature
- ♦ New, continuous cough
- ♦ Loss or change to sense of smell or taste
